COURSE DESCRIPTION (see relevant examples shown on website):

Students will learn the basic of Ceramic's beginning with pouring a mold to painting on greenware and moving on to bisque. Different techniques using different paints and media's are offered as each student perfects in their knowledge of Ceramics or painting.

SYLLABUS/OUTLINE: WEEKLY BREAKDOWN OF PROJECT-BASED LEARNING ACTIVITY

Students will weekly continue with the project they have started on the week prior. Instructions will be given to help each student achieve their goal of making the best project to their ability, while learning new techniques throughout the semester.

COURSE OBJECTIVES AND APPROXIMATE TARGET DATES:

Students will become proficient at basic knowledge of the ceramic industry. Differences in materials as well as outcomes reached by the materials used on different ceramic pieces

Note: All classes must abide by the following:

- 1) Student agrees to attend at least 80% of class sessions/lessons offered. Attendance is kept online and tracked by Partnership staff. Failure to meet 80% or be on track to meet 80% may result in program discontinuation.
- 2) The Partnership Student Assessment or Performance Form is filled out by the teacher and turned in to staff. The link to the evaluation form will be provided along with online attendance. Students with failing marks for lack of participation, behavior issues, practice time, etc. may result in program dismissal.
