DRAWING and PAINTING will be the primary focus as students create a series of projects to challenge their technical skills and understanding of composition. This is an excellent opportunity for students to begin preparation of portfolios for college applications, scholarships competitions, job interviews, and personal development. Students will participate in class CRITIQUES throughout each project, to develop skills in communication and working in collaborative environments.
