Short media demos will be presented and students have the opportunity to explore and develop personal creativity through the process of “planning”, “making” and “reflecting” in their art making. Students are encouraged and supported in artistic behaviors and are able to make authentic choices for personal art making in response to their own ideas and interests. Individual instruction provided according to what emerges through student-driven art making. Student work will be collected in both a physical and online “portfolio” that can continue to develop over time.
