## Y.57.1: Painting Exploration (10 students max)

AGES 5-7

(12) MONDAYS, 1-3 PM

SEPTEMBER 18 - DECEMBER 11 (NO CLASS NOVEMBER 20)

Experiment with a variety of painting media, techniques, and surfaces with artist **Amy Story**! In addition to traditional brushes and canvas, students will use sponges, rollers, bubble wrap, collaged elements and more to create colorful textured artworks. Inspiring art historical examples will be introduced alongside hands-on art projects.

Learn to create wacky characters using simple geometric shapes with instructor **Keith Stevens**! Students will bring their characters to life in drawings, paintings, and clay projects.

Students will develop their fine motor skills while enjoying the medium of clay with artist **Sherrie Styx**! Projects will begin with simple pinch pots and get more complex as other techniques are introduced, including coiling, slab-construction, and glazing.

Students will learn a variety of techniques to create forms out of clay- including coil, slab, press molds and wheel throwing. **Jennifer Zona** will teach students to combine these techniques to make both representational and non-representational artworks.
